Dr. Elizabeth Gaufberg is an Associate Professor of Medicine and Psychiatry at HMS, the Director of the Cambridge Health Alliance Center for Professional Development and the Jean and Harvey Picker Director of the Arnold P. Gold Foundation Research Institute. Liz edits *Auscultations*, CHA's award-winning literary arts journal, and has established an active collaboration between the Cambridge Health Alliance and the Harvard Art Museums. She loves to use art and literature to help medical trainees cultivate compassion and reflect on their own professional identity formation.



Dr. Amy Ship is an Assistant Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School, and a primary care doctor and educator at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center. She received a B.A. in English Literature from Swarthmore College, and an M.A. in Art History from Columbia University. Before becoming a physician, she worked as a curatorial assistant at two major art museums, and wrote for a national newspaper. At BIDMC, Amy directs the Katherine Swan Ginsburg Program for Humanism in Medicine. She teaches medical students, doctors in training, and faculty in diverse settings using poetry and the visual arts to enhance empathy and reflect on cognitive skills and caregiving.

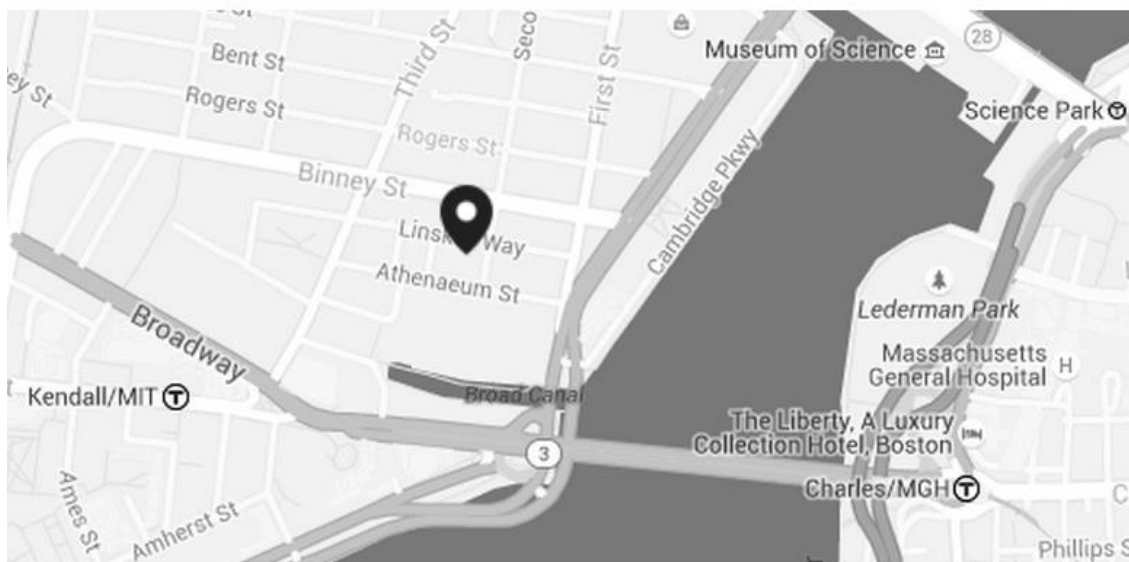
